

## **PRACTICE DIRECTIVE**

### **Order Made when Extension of Time Refused**

When an application to extend the time to file an appeal record, transcript, appeal book or appellant's factum has been refused by a justice in chambers, unless a justice otherwise orders, the order shall include a direction that the appeal is dismissed as abandoned pursuant to s. 10(2)(e) of the *Court of Appeal Act*. If there is a reason why the appeal should not be dismissed as abandoned, counsel should raise the issue at the hearing.

The order should also indicate any disposition as to costs, either as made by the justice or as otherwise permitted by law.
