

PRACTICE DIRECTIVE

Joint Appeal Books and Transcript Extracts

Parties wishing to file joint appeal books pursuant to Rule 26(3) (4) and Rule 27 may agree to file the appellant's factum, the respondent's factum and the joint appeal books at the same time. This allows the parties to make proper references to the appeal book material in their factums. The parties must file their joint appeal books and factums within 120 days of the appellant filing the appeal record. At the time of filing the appeal books, the parties must also file a consent order extending the time for filing the appeal books and factums signed by all parties to the appeal.
