

Practice Note
Release of Court of Appeal Reserve Reasons for Judgment by E-Mail

Commencing September 7, 2010, the Court of Appeal will accommodate requests from counsel and litigants to receive reserved judgments released in chambers by e-mail. Once counsel or a party is notified of the release date of reserve reasons for judgment by the registry staff, counsel should send an e-mail to the Court of Appeal reserve judgment office at ca-rj@courts.gov.bc.ca .

In order to obtain the correct judgment, please include in the e-mail subject line the Court of Appeal number (CA0XXXXX), a short style of cause, and the date the judgment is being released (July 15, 2010).

Example: Subject: CA012345 *Smith v. Jones* July 15, 2010

The judgment will be e-mailed to you by reply e-mail at the same time it is released in chambers. This will usually be at 9:30 a.m.

For your information, the judgment will usually appear on the court's website before noon the same day that it is released. The website is www.courts.gov.bc.ca
