Short Notice Applications - Civil

Summary:

This Practice Direction provides a variation of the Requisition in Form 17 that may be used by a party making a short notice application under Supreme Court Civil Rule 8-5.

Direction:

1. A short notice application under Rule 8-5(1) may be made by:
 - a. filing a Requisition in the form attached as Schedule A, with supporting material,
 - b. attending for the hearing of the short notice application.
2. If no judge or master is available, the short notice application may be heard by a legally trained registrar.
