**Direction:**

1. The proceedings at a judicial case conference are confidential.
2. Unless otherwise ordered by the court, no one may access a recording or a transcript of the recording of a judicial case conference.
3. A document entitled "*Litigants' Guide to Judicial Case Conferences*" has been developed to assist parties to prepare for judicial cases conferences.
